REPORTS

1. Saint Report

Traditionally at Confirmation, students adopt a Saint's Name. Please submit a report on the Saint that you have chosen. I encourage you to research a saint that may already share your name. You may also choose a saint that is the patron saint of a career or interest.

In the report, you should identify when the saint lived and significant moments of their lives. You should describe why you have chosen this saint and what about the life of the saint that you want to imitate.

2. Sponsor Report

You will need to identify one person to be your sponsor for the sacrament of Confirmation. This person must be Catholic, confirmed and over the age of 16. The sponsor needs to be active in the faith and living the precepts of the Catholic Church.

During the holidays is an excellent time to interview your sponsor. Ask them about their confirmation. How do they experience God in their daily lives? What do they do to show their love of God and of neighbor? Don't forget to ask them about their teenage years and how they became the person you have chosen to be a sponsor.

In the report, write a brief biography of your sponsor. Why did you choose this person and what about their Christian life do you want to imitate?
